INFORMATION ABOUT THE MANDATORY RECORDING OF PERSONAL DATA

Dear Guest!

We hereby inform you that in accordance with current legislation, after 1st September 2021, the personal data of all guests who use accommodation services in Hungary, as defined by law, will be recorded through the accommodation provider's document reader, record in the accommodation management software, and then must be forwarded to the Guest Information Closed Database (VIZA).

The data to be recorded are:

- surname and first name;
- surname and first name at birth;
- place of birth;
- date of birth;
- gender;
- nationality;
- mother's maiden name, surname and first name (if it is shown on the identity card);
- data of identity card or travel document;
- in case of a third-country national**, the number of the visa or residence permit, the date and place of entry

In order to record the data, the guest using the accommodation service presents his/her identity card, driver's license or travel document suitable for identification to the accommodation provider. Failing to present the document, the accommodation provider will refuse providing the accommodation service. Based on the authorization by legislation, the accommodation provider is entitled to request the guest's identity document, and the guest is obliged to present it.
